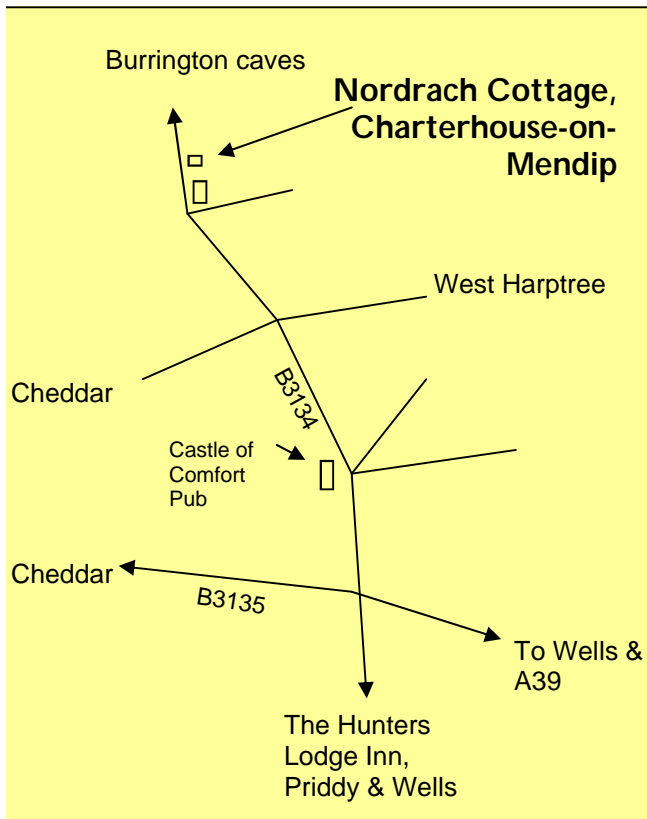

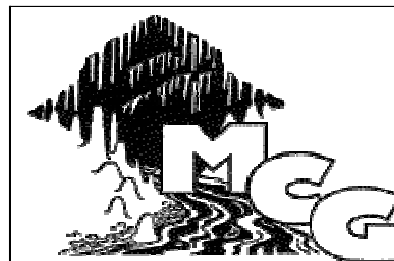


THE MENDIP CAVING GROUP

Cottage Facilities

Nearby Caves

Lounge area



The lounge area has a multi-fuel stove and dining area with easy access to the kitchen.



Facilities include:

- 3 bedrooms with comfortable bunks sleeping 30 people (please bring your own sleeping bags/linen)
- Storage heaters
- Shower room/changing room
- Multi-fuel stove (fuel provided)
- Fully equipped kitchen (with gas cooker, additional gas hobs, fridge, microwave and food storage shelves)
- Parking for 8 cars plus further off road parking
- Hosing down area
- Gas and electricity included
- Payphone
- Camping area
- Charging area (for charging batteries)



Within walking distance are the Charterhouse caves (e.g. Upper flood, Waterwheel) and Pine-tree Pot. Close by are GB Cavern, Longwood August, Tynning's Barrow, Rhino Rift. Burrington Combe is 5mins drive and Priddy 10 mins.

CCC permits and keys are available by prior arrangement.

Local Attractions

Nearby tourist attractions include Cheddar Gorge 18mins by car, Wells/ Wookey Hole 22mins, Bath 30mins, Weston-Super-Mare 30mins, Glastonbury 36mins. Walkers will enjoy the superb local walks straight from the cottage and the many conservation areas.

Accommodation would be ideally suited to large groups such as universities, scout groups, walkers, cyclists, etc as a base for outdoor and leisure activities.

Bedrooms



Comfortable bunks. Rooms sleep 6, 8 and 16 people; two have hand-basins. All have storage heating.

With rope washer and high pressure hose for cleaning dirty caving suits and equipment.
